



Birchwood Dress Code Policy

Birchwood's dress code is designed to foster an atmosphere of respect. Students, staff and other members of our school community are expected to wear appropriate clothing to school and school related activities. The following regulations will be in effect at this school:

Hats can be worn in the cafeteria but not during school hours unless authorized by the administration.

Footwear must be worn at all times for health and safety reasons (sudden evacuation of the building).

Clothing that will be considered inappropriate include:

- too revealing or low cut (need to cover stomach and back. No undergarments should be visible)
- contain profanity (text or graphic)
- derogatory or demeaning messages

The administration has the right to determine the appropriateness of clothing. Members of the school community who do not follow dress expectations will be required to change into other clothing that meets expectations. The school is prepared to provide appropriate clothing if necessary. Students may be asked to call/sent home and to replace clothing. Repeated violations to the dress code may result in further consequences.
