# **Camps Rules & Behavioral Policy**

We want all of our campers to have a positive experience with the Canadian Red Cross Water Safety Day camps. In order to assure that participants are safe and the camps are fun for everyone involved, we have the following camp rules and behavioral policy.

Campers and staff are expected to follow these **Camp Rules**:

- 1. Show respect...for yourself, each other, nature and your surroundings
- 2. Behave in a safe manner; running, hitting, fighting, throwing sand and foul language are not appropriate and will not be tolerated.
- 3. Campers should always listen to instructors.
- 4. Campers must stay within designated class activity area, unless their instructor has given them permission to leave.
- 5. Campers and staff will not eat food during non-lunch or snack times.
- 6. Games and electronic items are not allowed.
- 7. Have fun!!

## If any of the above rules are violated, the following steps will be taken:

- Offenders will first be warned that they are breaking a rule, educated about it, and have the rule explained to them.
- The second time a person breaks the same rule they will get a time out from the activity or swim, and be warned that if it happens again they will be asked to leave.
- Third time offenders will be asked to leave the group activity. The Field Supervisor will be informed if any child is continually breaking rules. Families may be notified if the behavior continues, and depending on the severity, the child may be removed from camps.

I have read and understand the rules and will help enforce them. In addition, I have read and explained the camp rules to my child and believe that he/she understands them.
