



CURLING CLUB Junior Curling and After-School Program 2018-2019

Dear Parents and Curlers,

Another year of curling is getting started and we are looking forward to working with each one of you. Children 12 & under must wear a CSA approved helmet while they are on the ice. It is important that they dress warmly as they will be on the ice for about an hour.

We provide brooms and sliders, so besides warm clothing (including gloves) and a helmet, they will need a clean pair of sneakers that have grip on them.

We also provide a snack at the end of each curling day, so please let us know if your child has any allergies.

The After-School Program is on **Tuesdays** and runs from 3:00-4:30 pm. The bus from Englewood drops them off at the curling club and parents need to have the children picked up at 4:30 pm.

The cost for the After-School Program /Junior Novice is \$108.49 including fees and taxes. This membership allows the curler to attend the Monday After-School Program sessions only. The Junior Full membership is \$191.50 with tax, including fees and taxes. A Junior Full membership allows the curler to practice anytime ice is available and curl on any league nights.

If school is cancelled due to weather, curling will also be cancelled.
