Parents are urged to register their children for Kindergarten as soon as possible. It is important that schools have registration information in order to contact parents regarding the upcoming Welcome to Kindergarten Program and to assign teaching staff to schools, in particular, the Kindergarten classes.

FAQ Where do you register? : Local school that your child is zoned to attend

What you need: a. For proof of child's age provide: (i) Birth Certificate (ii) PEI Health Card b. For proof of home address provide: (i) Verification of home address (copy of utility bill, etc.) Age requirement: Child must be 5 Years old by December 31, 2018 Additional questions: Please call your local school or School District Office (Stratford 368-6990 or Summerside 888-8400)
