

Launch of Charlottetown Family of Schools Study and Consultation

Projections show that six schools in the Charlottetown Family of Schools may be at or near capacity in 3 to 5 years. The six schools identified are Charlottetown Rural, Colonel Gray, Birchwood, Queen Charlotte, Spring Park, and West Kent.

A review of these schools is being completed to respond to the enrolment projections and expected population growth.

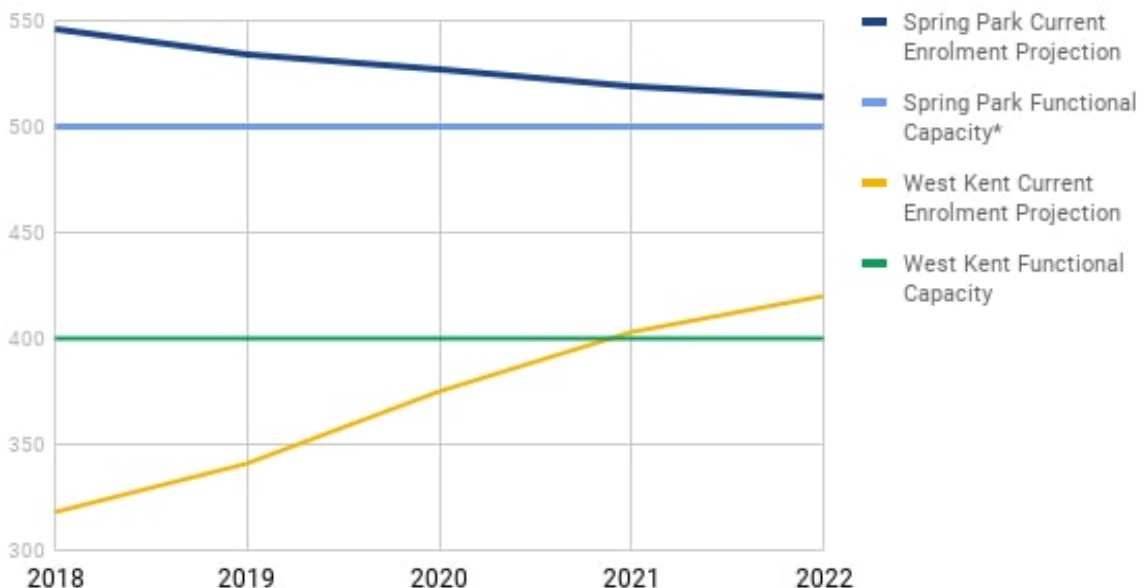
Information and public input is being gathered to inform planning and recommendations to provide all students with adequate space and high quality learning environments.

Public consultations will be held to explore these challenges and help to shape solutions on the following dates:

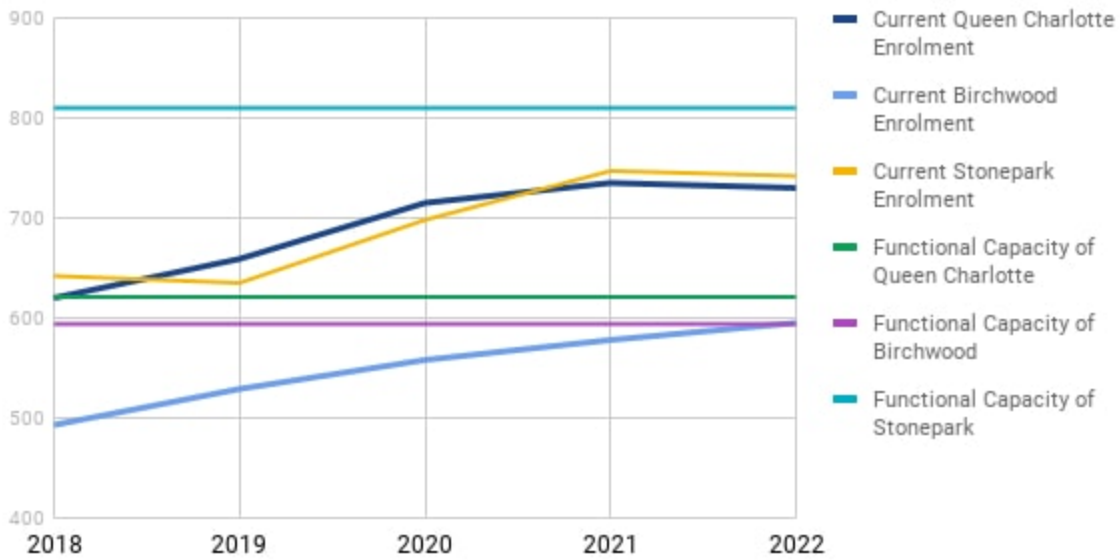
- **Elementary schools** (Spring Park and West Kent) Monday, June 25, 7:00-8:30 pm at Colonel Gray
- **High schools** (Charlottetown Rural and Colonel Gray) Wednesday, June 27, 7:00-8:30 pm at Charlottetown Rural High School
- **Intermediate schools** (Birchwood and Queen Charlotte) Thursday, June 28, 7:00-8:30 pm at Charlottetown Rural High School

Parents and community members are invited to attend and share their views and ideas. Participants will take part in focused discussions on possible solutions that could include rezoning, adding more space to existing schools or new school construction. Those who are unable to attend a consultation meeting will have the opportunity to contribute via an online survey covering the same discussion points as the public meetings. The survey will be posted on June 25, 2018 to the Public Schools Branch website.
