Program Outline

- 1 hour 30 minutes of on-ice instruction, per week, based on Hockey Canada's Skill Development Program. Tuesdays 2:20-3:50, 12 sessions
(**First group/session: Gr. 8-9, mid-October to mid-January**)
(**Second group/session: Gr. 7 & others, mid-January - March/April**)
- Off-ice hockey instruction that includes off-ice **6-7 hours of off-ice instruction** (*fitness training, nutritional education, hockey theory, mental preparation, leadership training and HCSA curriculum*)

School Credit

- Program will be an extension of Physical Education and Health curriculum

Transportation

- Students will walk or be responsible for transportation to **Cody Banks Arena**
- Families are responsible to drop off hockey gear at Cody Banks, either prior to school or during lunch hour. It will be kept in secured dressing room.
- Students will need to be picked up at Cody Banks at 4:00pm

Equipment

- Students will be responsible to supply their own equipment
- Please note that all equipment must meet Hockey Canada Standards which includes a Full-face shield with the helmet

Eligibility

- Students must fill out an application
- Application must be sent to Stonepark Intermediate School
- This program is open to any female, male, or gender-neutral student in grade seven to nine enrolled at Stonepark Intermediate School
